Born in 1994 in Geneva, Thomas Liu Le Lann lives and works in Geneva.

Thomas Liu Le Lann is an artist who creates sculptures and installations using various techniques involving fabric, glass, wood, photography, video, poetry, and found objects. His environments evoke his own life experiences through a logic of play, subversion, and autofiction. The objects he summons are reimagined, changing in scale, materials, and often encountering "soft heroes", human-like protagonists who languidly inhabit his exhibitions.

He obtained his M.F.A. in Visual Arts from the HEAD, Geneva School of Art and Design, in 2018, winning the New Heads Foundation BNP Paribas Prize as well as the Head Gallery Prize in 2018. In 2023, he was laureate of the Grants of the City of Geneva Berthoud, Lissignol-Chevalier and Galland for young contemporary creation.

Thomas Liu Le Lann has had several solo exhibitions, including *Training Part 7*, la Samaritaine, Paris (2023); *French Toast*, VinVin, Naples (2023); *Milo*, Dittrich & Schlechtriem, Berlin (2021); *17*, Xippas, Paris (2021); *Best Western*, LUBOV, New York (2019); *Ziwen, You Deserve All the Flowers that Still Grow on Earth*, Xippas, Geneva (2019); *I'm not okay*, VinVin, Vienna (2019); *ShowDown*, MBAL, Le Locle (2018); *19.07*, Maladie d'Amour, Grenoble (2018). In 2024, his work will be presented in the exhibitions *Entertainment*, E-WERK, Freiburg im Breisgau (12.09.24 - 10.11.24), and *GYM*, Embassy of Switzerland, Paris (24.07.24 - 08.09.24).

His work has also been shown in group exhibitions such as *Naturaleza Abstracta*, Xippas, Punta del Este (2024); *Grants of the City of Geneva*, Centre d'Art Contemporain, Geneva (2023); *Highlights aus der Sammlung Jakob*, E-WERK, Freiburg im Breisgau (2023); *Claustrophobia Alpina III: Relief*, Forde, Geneva (2023); *Barbe à Papa*, CAPC, Bordeaux (2022); *Baby, Welcome to the Party*, Maison des Arts Georges & Claude Pompidou (MAGCP), Carjac (2022); *GENEVA DECADE*, Xippas, Geneva (2021); *Uplift*, Xippas, Geneva (2020); *Études sur l'Empathie*, Fondation d'entreprise Ricard, Paris (2019).
